NOTICE OF PROPOSED
SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE
MATERIAL REGULATION BYLAW

The Council of the City of Dawson Creek is proposing to regulate, prohibit and impose requirements in relation to the use of waste disposal and recycling services and is proposing the Solid Waste and Recyclable Material Regulation Bylaw No. 4380, 2018 and would like to extend the public notice of the proposed changes.

In general terms, the proposed changes include:

Type of Service	Fee
Garbage Curbside pickup - first Collection Cart	\$12.00 Per Month
Garbage Curbside pickup - second Collection Cart	\$12.00 Per Month
Recyclable Material Curbside pickup - first Collection Cart	\$6.86 Per Month
Recyclable Material Curbside pickup - second Collection Cart	\$6.86 Per Month
Purchase of second collection cart	Cost plus 15% administration fee
