



Leisure Access Program – Trusted Partners

A Trusted Partner must be able to confirm:

1. The applicant is a permanent resident of Dawson Creek (and has resided within City boundaries for a minimum of three months);
2. Additional applicants listed reside at the address noted; and,
3. The applicant is at or below the recognized Statistics Canada Low Income Cut Off threshold.

A Trusted Partner is defined as any of the following:

- Social Service Agency
- Government Agency
- Non-Profit organization working with an individual or family and capable of verifying the applicant's income status
