## GENERAL LOCAL ELECTION OCTOBER 20<sup>th</sup>

### Where do I vote?

Advance Voting and General Local Election Day voting take place at the Calvin Kruk Centre for the Arts 10401 – 10th Street, Dawson Creek, BC.

### Can I vote before October 20th?

Yes, you will be able to vote from 8 am to 8 pm, on October 10th and 17th at the Advance Polls.

### Am I eligible to vote?

To be eligible to vote you MUST meet ALL of the following:

- 18 years of age or older on voting day
- a Canadian citizen
- a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of voting
- a resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Dawson Creek for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the other property owners.

### Can I vote on the Internet, by mail or by phone?

No. You must cast your ballot in person.

### I own property in BC and live in a different province or country, can I vote?

No. You must be a resident of BC for at least 6 months.

### I own more than one property in the same jurisdiction, can I vote more than once?

No. You may only vote once, either as a resident property owner or as a non-resident property owner, regardless of the number of properties you own in one jurisdiction.

### I own more than one property, but they are in different jurisdictions, can I vote in each jurisdiction?

Yes. You may vote for Mayor and Council in multiple jurisdictions if you have owned property within each jurisdiction for at least 30 days before registering to vote, but you can only vote in one jurisdiction for school district trustees.

### I own a property with someone else and neither of us live on the property, can both of us vote?

No. Only one non-resident property owner may vote per property.

### I own a property with someone else that is living in the house, can both of us vote?

Yes, the person living in the house can register as a resident elector and you can register as a non-resident elector if you are not eligible to vote as a resident elector under another property.

### I live in one town but go to school in another, can I vote in both places?

No. You can only vote in one jurisdiction. You may choose to vote where you attend school or normally live but not both.

### I own a company, do I get an extra vote?

No. Corporate votes are not allowed.
