








COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMUNICABLE DISEASE PREVENTION PLAN

(Kenn Borek Aquatic Centre, Recreation Programs, Kin and Memorial Arenas, Sports fields, and Parks)

	<p>Stay home if you are sick</p>
	<p>Wash hands regularly with soap for at least 20 seconds</p>
	<p>Cover your mouth and nose with a disposable tissue or crease of your elbow when you sneeze or cough</p>
	<p>Respect personal space</p>
	<p>Disinfect equipment and surfaces regularly</p>
	<p>Avoid sharing food, drinks and equipment</p>
	<p>Avoid unnecessary contact</p>

COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMUNICABLE DISEASE PREVENTION PLAN

1. Patrons must stay home if sick and not enter the facility.
2. If patron starts to show symptoms of sickness after arrival, they must leave. If patron is a child, isolate patron until a guardian can pick them up.
